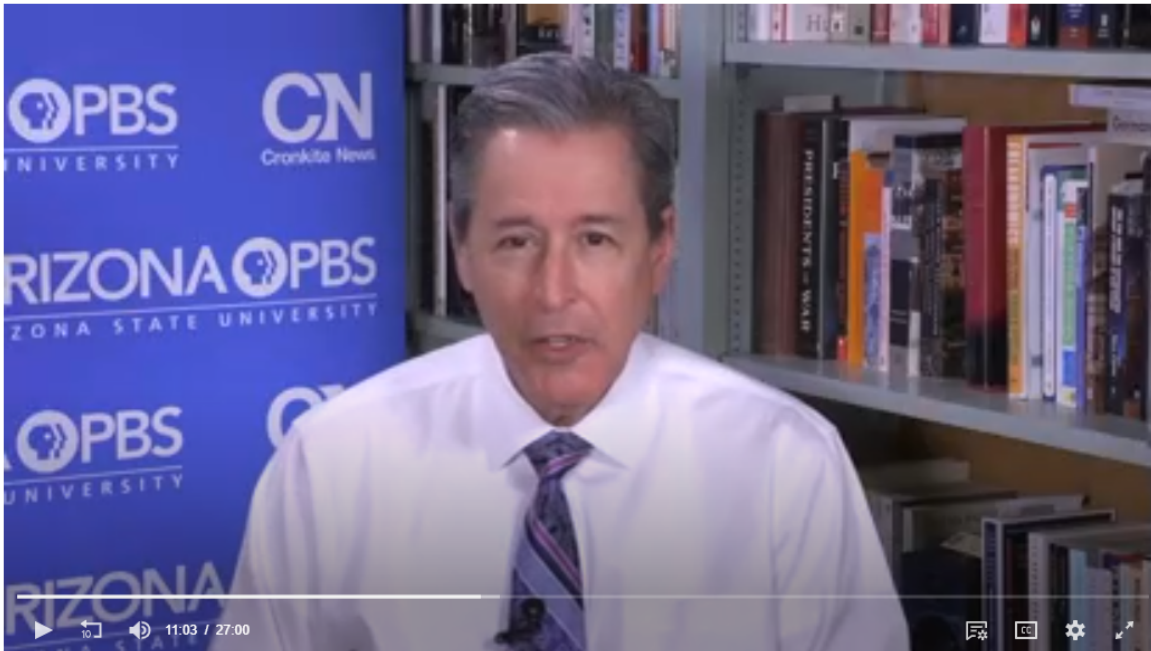


# Legal ramifications for businesses reopening during the pandemic
